WILLIAMSBURG — The Seaway Valley Singers will present their Christmas concert on Sunday, December 14, at 3:00 p.m., at the Christian Reformed Church in Williamsburg, under the direction of Robert Jones, with accompaniment provided by pianist Margaret Whisselle.

SVS will present a varied program, featuring sacred and secular music for Advent, Christmas and Hanukkah. From traditional settings of Gesù Bambino (featuring soprano Margaret Whisselle and violinist Dan Edwards), The First Nowell, Chestnuts Roasting on an Open Fire and Ring, Christmas Bells to Cree composer Andrew Balfour's stirring setting of Coventry Carol, from a chorus of Vivaldi's Gloria to Hanukkah Night and A One-Horse Open Sleigh (a slightly different take on Jingle Bells), the concert will delight audiences of all ages.

A highlight, no doubt, will be the Hallelujah Chorus (from Handel's Messiah).
